Passpro

Passpro Boxed Service provides a secure way for employees to reset their passwords without IT assistance.

Password management and user provisioning is becoming more challenging for IT management. The demand for greater security to safeguard company assets, ensure privacy and maintain consumer confidence have made password management and its parent, identity management key initiatives that support business continuity and improved risk management.

To enforce security, some organizations have imposed password policies such as password rotation, password length and complexity. These measures have lowered productivity and increased IT costs as users easily get locked out of their systems. To counter this, people have adopted insecure tactics to remember passwords such as writing them down or sharing passwords with colleague. As a result, the initial objective of ensuring security is lost while productivity is lowered and IT support costs have increased.

Boonbox recognize the need for security and the role password management and policies play. Security Compliance

In a large organization that receives hundreds of helpdesk requests per day, each password reset request may cost a company \$30 to \$70 to resolve, according to IDC analysts.

This represents the cost of paying the helpdesk employee to resolve the issue. It also includes the lost productivity from the employee who is locked out of their workstation during the password reset process. Passpro eliminates this wasted time.

Devfense

Devfense boxed service enables organizations to ensure continuity of business operations and enhance customer service through web application security compliance.

A web security breach can shut down an organization's website, distribute malware, result in identity, or data loss. The company facing the breach will suffer from loss or consumer confidence, potential fines and litigation as well as decreased revenues. Devfense helps organizations avoid these losses but also enables organizations to have a proactive approach to security.

Better Productivity

Devfense customers reduce IT costs significantly. It would take a team of IT security specialists working year-round to manually check for web application code vulnerabilities or to just keep an application secure for a single set of security compliance regulations. With the resulting analysis and recommendations produce by Devfense Boxed Service, IT resources can concentrate on fix code recommendations and other functional development efforts.

Security Compliance

With the increasing number of publicized web security breaches, both government and industry have developed compliance regulations to protect their industries and customers.

Devfense provides a comprehensive report against standard web application security threats such as those identified by OWASP, SANs and WASC. Furthermore, Devfense can also identify issues web applications may have in meeting compliance regulations.

Devfense supports a number of compliance regulations including: Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS), Payment Application Best Practices (PABP), Health Insurance

Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), and Gramm-Leach Bliley Act (GLBA), Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA) and Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA) to easily address auditing requirements.

Return on Investment

Devfense provides ROI in three ways: boosting the online revenue-generating potential of a website, web security breach avoidance and significant cost savings from reduced IT costs.

Organizations that publicize their web security efforts tend to see higher sales conversion rates. Vendor-supplied data indicates conversion increases may be as high as 14 per cent. For a company that generates \$1 million in sales or donations online, this could represent \$140,000 in extra revenue. In less than one month, Devfense could pay for itself just from the added revenue boost from publicizing security efforts.

Companies that prevent a data security breach may see a return on investment of hundreds of thousands or even tens of millions of dollars by purchasing Devfense. Data breach costs from civil litigation, damage control measures and after-the-breach quick fixes can add up to tens of millions of dollars in liability.

Another aspect of Devfense's ROI is that organizations can avoid the heavy cost of a security breach. Experts suggest a single average breach could result in the loss of 99,000 records on average. A corporate security breach of that size could cost an organization between \$9 million and \$14 million in legal bills, crisis management measures and after-the-fact security improvements (Darwin Professional Underwriters). Given that just one in 30 websites is estimated by industry analysts to be secure and the costs of a breach are so astronomical, web security breach avoidance is a critical and necessary part of every organization's overall security strategy.

Finally, Devfense can provide immediate cost savings through the replacement of time-intensive, error-prone manual security web audits with automated scans. Manual web security audits may cost upwards of \$250,000 just to pay a team of internal IT auditors' salaries. With Devfense, that cost is eliminated. Devfense could pay for itself through IT resource savings after just a week to 10 days.
